### Saloon

The Saloon is beautifully designed. It has a warm, inviting atmosphere, with its cherry wood and large windows. The settee is L-shaped and right in the middle of the saloon. It's on a platform, allowing you to see everything, and there's even storage space underneath. The table can be used as a coffee table or a dining table. It features folding corners, allowing you to adjust the size to accommodate the number of people present. There's also an entertainment unit on the back wall. It's 19 inches deep and features numerous drawers and cupboards. The washer and dryer are also tucked away in there. There's also a raised shelf for storing charts.

# Galley

The galley is on the port side of the ship. You can access it by some stairs that resemble the ones in your house. It's also open to the salon. The cabinetry is exceptionally well-made, and the wood is consistently cherry throughout.

The master cabin is on the starboard side of the boat. After going down two stairs, you'll find the master's room, which has a big stateroom, a dressing room, and a huge head.

The Vessel has a Main, Self-Tacking Jib, Genoa, Screecher, and Spinnaker. The mast is Selden, featuring powered in-mast furling, a deck-stepped anodized aluminum furling mast, and a double diamond stay configuration. The boom is supported by a Selden Rod 4

Kicker vang with a gas strut.

- Engine room blowers to take heat from the engine rooms when the
- engines shut down. When running the engines with the blowers off, it gives adequate back feed of fresh air to the engines for combustion

### Exterior

- Deck Hardware
  - Spinlock Line clutches 6 at aft winch, four at forward winch, one on bowsprit
  - Mooring cleat (12") with fairlead on each bow

# • Deck Lockers

- A port forward locker with steps attached to the outboard wall provides access to sail storage and the holding tank for the port head, accessed via a Bomar hatch.
- The starboard forward locker, equipped with steps attached to the outboard wall, provides access to the generator, a large storage area, and a holding tank for the starboard head. The Bomar hatch features a ventilator and LED lighting.
- The center forward locker, equipped with a stainless steel ladder, contains ship service batteries in a fiberglass enclosure. This provides access to the windlass motor and mast wiring, as well as a tunnel under the bridge deck. The locker also features storage for fenders and lines. It is equipped with a Bomar hatch, ventilator, and an Intensity fluorescent lamp.
- Anchor locker for primary anchor and chain (can be retrofitted to be divided for two anchors if necessary), capstan for windlass, remote control for windlass, deck wash spray with both salt and fresh water supply, access to fillers for fresh water tanks.
- Center cockpit lazarette with double door entry gives access to refrigeration
- compressors, steering components, autopilot drive unit, and a large storage area, including extra lines
- Aft storage bench seats with Starboard dividers include rope compartments and propane tanks 20lb bottles, primary plus one spare, plus space for 4 66 cu-ft scuba tanks
- Transom lockers provide access to the shaft steering system, watermaker, SSB tuner, and storage, including extra fuel containers, an emergency bilge pump, and other items.
- Sunbrella hatch covers (tan)

- ProMarine 60-amp galvanic isolator

- 12VDC: Paneltronics 24x 15-amp breakers with 115-amp main switch, voltmeter for reading all batteries, line voltage meter for shore power/generator input, and amp meter for reading load current, all at Nav Station.
- 110VAC: Paneltronics 11 breakers with main supply safety breakers either connect shore power or generator, not both. Can parallel the input such that only one shore power connection will work, should you only want to hook up with a single 30 amp rather than 2 X 30 amps.
